VINTAGE SUMMARY

The Sauvignon Blanc was sourced from the Russian River appellation which has gravelly soil that produces some of the county's most treasured wines. The wine was fermented and aged in stainless steel and kept cool to preserve the aromatics and bright flavors.

TASTING NOTES

Aromatics of citrus, grass and fine, crisp tropical notes combine with flavors of grapefruit, green apple, pineapple make way for a tart, crispy finish.
