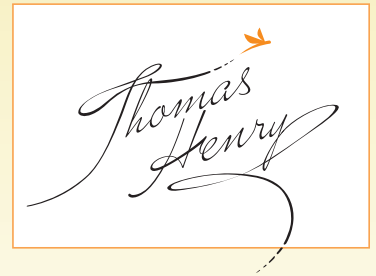


All Thomas Henry Wines are single varietals that originate from California's finest appellations.

## 2011 THOMAS HENRY ZINFANDEL

### VINTAGE SUMMARY

The 2010 Thomas Henry Zinfandel is vinified in a traditional method of regular pump-overs to extract fine dark color, firm flavor tannins and dark cherry and briary berry flavors. The wine is pressed firmly to extract the deeper tannins in the skins and then aged in a blend of 30% new French and Pennsylvania oak with the remainder in neutral Hungarian oak barrels. The wine is typically bottled within 16 to 18 months.

### TASTING NOTES

Dark berry flavors of cherry and blackberry coupled with a touch of Asian spice and some plum notes also dominate the palate. The firm tannins linger easily with the fruit and chocolate notes.
