VINTAGE SUMMARY

The fruit for the 2011 Thomas Henry Riesling is sourced from the Luna Vista Vineyard at the Borden Ranch outside of Lodi, California. Fermented in stainless steel and kept cool to preserve the aromatics. The lees are stirred regularly to build structure and depth.

TASTING NOTES

This Riesling has a powerful and distinctive floral, apricot and apple-like aroma that leads to bright flavors of pear, lychee fruit, peach and apricot that will dominate the palate. The wine is crisp and yet has a fruity finish and clean acidity.
